



CLEAN SWEEP ACCEPTED ITEMS



REDUCE the amount of potentially hazardous product you buy and keep in your house.
 Read labels for warnings and disposal instructions. Only buy what you can use entirely.
 Check the product label for safe storage and disposal directions.

CAR and AUTOMOTIVE CARE PRODUCTS	
Household Hazardous Waste	Safe disposal options
Antifreeze	Bring to participating auto service centers or county hazardous waste collection event
Brake fluid	Bring to participating auto service centers or county hazardous waste collection event
Carburetor cleaner	Bring to county hazardous waste collection event
Degreasers	Bring to county hazardous waste collection event
Gasoline and fuels	Bring to county hazardous waste collection event
Tires	Trade-in at participating auto service centers or bring to county tire collection event
Transmission fluid	Bring to participating auto service centers or county hazardous waste collection event
HOUSEHOLD CLEANING PRODUCTS	
Household Hazardous Waste	Safe disposal options
<p>* Never mix products containing ammonia with those containing bleach. ** Solvent-containing products are labelled as: "flammable," "combustible" or "containing petroleum distillates."</p>	
Concrete cleaners (acid)	Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.
Metal cleaners	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.
Polish with solvents**	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.
Pool chemicals	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event.

HOME IMPROVEMENT PRODUCTS	
Household Hazardous Waste	Safe disposal options
** Solvent-containing products are labelled as: "flammable," "combustible" or "containing petroleum distillates."	
Adhesives with solvents**	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event.
Floor/wax stripper	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event.
Furniture stripper	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event.
Lighter fluid	Bring to county hazardous waste collection event
Paint, latex-based	Air-dry or mix with cat litter until solid - place in regular trash OR \$5/gallon and \$25/5-gallon pail fee at Clean Sweep
Paint, oil-based	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. \$5/gallon and \$25/5-gallon fee at Clean Sweep.
Paint remover/thinner	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event.
Sealers	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.
Stain, varnish, lacquer	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event.
Turpentine	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.
Wood preservatives	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event.
PESTICIDES, WEED KILLERS and POISONS	
Household Hazardous Waste	Safe disposal options
Fertilizer with weed killer	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.
Flea spray	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.
Insect/bug killer	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider snap traps or chalk lines to keep out ants.
Mothballs	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using cedar chips or lavender.
Rat/rodent poison	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.
Weed killer	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS	
Household Hazardous Waste	Safe disposal options
Mercury Thermometers and thermostats	Keep sealed. Bring to county hazardous waste collection event or appliance collection event.
Smoke detectors	Bring to county hazardous waste collection event.
PRESSURIZED CONTAINERS	
Household Hazardous Waste	Safe disposal options
<i>Pressurized containers can explode under heat or pressure and should be kept out of regular waste collection.</i>	
Aerosol cans	Keep sealed and deliver to a collection facility or event. Consider using a non-hazardous alternative.
Propane tanks (refillable)	Refill at supplier. If disposing of tank, keep sealed. Bring to county appliance collection event .
Propane tanks (small, single-use, non-refillable)	Use entire contents of tank so that it is empty. Bring to a county appliance collection event .
