CDD Fees & Policies

Policies Applicable to All Fees and All Divisions of CDD

Required fees must be submitted at the time of application.

Fees will be doubled for applications submitted after construction has been initiated or written enforcement action has commenced.

Additional fees shall be paid as directed by the Community Development Director. If review time exceeds fees by 50 percent or more, additional hours may be billed.

When required, the cost of retained experts will be in addition to the applicable fees listed and will be paid by the applicant.

All fees are non-refundable

Withdrawal of applications will be refunded at a maximum of 90% of fee paid, 10% processing fee will be retained.

Cancellation requests for camp sites or shelter rentals will be provided a credit code valid for up to 1-year from date of issuance for parks use only. The \$10 reservation fee will not be included in the voucher amount.

Permit Compliance Deposit

Any permit or variance with conditions, per Ch. 16 Shoreland and Riverway section 17.36 J.8., shall pay a compliance deposit due at time of submittal or prior to issuance of permit. Deposit to cover actual cost of staff inspections for mitigation plans, some vegetation management activities, or as determined by the Zoning Administrator; including pre-construction, mid-construction, and post-construction meetings and completion of inspections for up to 2 (two) years from date of permit/variance issuance.
