



## **Resolution No. 4 (2020)**

### **RESOLUTION FOR REFERENDUM ON QUESTION FOR FAIR MAPS**

1       **WHEREAS**, under the state constitution, the majority party of the legislature is directed  
2 at its next session following the decennial federal census to redistrict legislative districts  
3 according to the number of inhabitants; and, at the same interval, the legislature also reapportions  
4 congressional districts pursuant to federal law; and

5       **WHEREAS**, the current procedure stifles political participation, discourages  
6 collaboration and compromise, and lacks the fairness necessary to our democratic process, by  
7 undermining the principle of one-person-one-vote; it allows the legislature to choose its voters  
8 rather than the voters choosing their representatives; and

9       **WHEREAS**, a non-partisan process promotes more accountability and transparency and  
10 prohibits the consideration of voting patterns, party information, and incumbents' residence  
11 information or demographic information in drawing the maps, except as necessary to ensure  
12 minority participation as required by the U.S. Constitution; and

13       **WHEREAS**, the 2011 Wisconsin legislative process to draw the maps and fight litigation  
14 contesting those maps cost taxpayers nearly \$1.9 million; and

15       **WHEREAS**, a panel of federal district court judges has ruled that the redistricting done  
16 in Wisconsin in 2011 was unconstitutional; and

17       **WHEREAS**, redistricting to achieve partisan gains is improper, whether it is done by  
18 Republicans or Democrats.

19       **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the St. Croix County Board of  
20 Supervisors insists upon the creation of a nonpartisan procedure of legislative and congressional  
21 redistricting plans.

22       **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the St. Croix County Board of Supervisors, in  
23 legal session assembled, does hereby approve that the following question be placed on the April  
24 7, 2020 Spring election ballot as an advisory referendum question:

25       **Question: Should St. Croix County request that the Wisconsin Legislature create a  
26 nonpartisan procedure for the preparation of legislative and congressional district plans  
27 and maps?**


